Invisible Odysseys is an art project which focuses on the lives of Mexican farmworkers who help keep the dairy industry alive in Vermont. Many have no formal immigration status, and therefore live submerged lives, largely invisible even to their neighbors. By providing them with art materials and support visits, some extraordinary works of art have emerged. Rather than being filtered through one of the many lenses that often frame immigrants, these pieces, and the companion statements, allow their unmediated voices and feelings to be expressed. In its colorful, highly charged

images and words, the book links their stories to the larger history of immigration sagas that have formed this country.
